House rules for the Camping site

Access to the campsite

- Reserved areas may not be used without special agreement.
- Access to and from the site outside opening hours can only be done by prior agreement.
- If you leave the site outside opening hours, contact the camping staff on duty by telephone. The number will be displayed at the entrance to the camping area.
- Opening hours for the camping area (it is possible to leave the site 24 hours a day if needed)
 - Thursday 0900 - 2230
 - Friday 0700 - 2230
 - Saturday 0700 - 2230
 - Sunday 0700 - 2230
 - Monday 0700 -

Guidelines in connection with location of camping unit.

- Staff will assign *all* units a place, unless otherwise agreed.
 - Campers must follow the instructions.
- From a unit and backwards must be min. 1.5 m. to the marking line on the grass.
- There must be 3-3.5 m between each unit. - Pulling clothes are not measured.
- The unit, possibly awning, must not exceed the line marking the access road.
- TimeWinder reserves the right to assess whether a device is set up incorrectly and possibly require it to be moved.
- In situations of doubt, the campsite staff are happy to help with a correct location.
- According to the fire authorities, it is NOT permitted to place a tent on the pitch by the caravans, they must be placed on the tent pitch.

Vehicles.

- There is an official requirement that vehicles may not stand up against a caravan and must therefore be parked on the other side of the access road, in the designated parking area. This must be done no later than one hour after the caravan has been placed.
- Be considerate on the site, all driving must take place at walking pace, <10 km/h.
 - Also applies to vintage cars!

Bath and toilet.

- Baths and toilets are free to use - be considerate of others and keep order.
 - Bring your own towel and toiletries.

In general.

- Be considerate of other guests - inconsiderate or noisy behavior may result in eviction and wristband clipping.
- Possibility of purchase, see notice at the camping information
- Open flames may only be present in the barbecue areas indicated by signage.
- The area around the camping unit must be kept clean and left clean when unpacking.
- It is forbidden to bury waste. It is always possible to requisition waste bags from the groundskeeper.
- Dogs are allowed, but not loose - litter is collected by the owner and disposed of in the provided waste bins.
- TimeWinder assumes no responsibility for damage or loss of the camping guests' belongings.
- Any perpetrators of damage to buildings, equipment or fellow campers' belongings can be held liable according to the general compensation rules.
